Can the battery be thrown away

Therefore, batteries shouldn't be thrown away or recycled like other household waste, like paper, plastic, or aluminum.

What happens if you throw away a battery?

It's actually quite a simple answer. When you throw something away into your household bins, for example, the majority of it ends up in landfill. Batteries contain harmful chemicals and substances that can leak into the ground once the battery coverings start to rot away.

Where can I dispose of old batteries?

These include disposing of AA and AAA batteries, 9v batteries, watch, camera, and electric toothbrush batteries. Recycling centres – lots of household waste recycling centres (HWRCs) also have battery bins for recycling. Check with your local authority to see if your nearest HWRC accepts old batteries.

Can batteries be recycled?

Basically, all batteries apart from those designed for vehicles or industrial use can be dropped off for recycling this way. (The terminals of lithium batteries should ideally be taped up first, to prevent any risk of fire.)



What should I do if my battery goes bad?

Keep your batteries in a cool, dry place. If your batteries become corroded or overheated, they could leak or rupture. It is also important to avoid storing your batteries near any flammable materials, as this could present a fire hazard. Tape the terminals of your batteries. Sometimes seemingly dead batteries still carry a bit of a charge.

Can you put batteries in a waste bin?

WRWA would like to remind residents that they should not put their batteries in a waste bin, recycling sack or wheely bin. Loose batteries, or electricals with batteries hidden inside, do need to be recycled separately. You'll find advice on where you can drop them off on our website.

How do you dispose of a leaking battery?

To dispose of leaky batteries, you should first put them in a clear plastic bag and seal it to prevent anyone from coming into direct contact with these hazardous materials. Then you can dispose of the leaking batteries the same as any old batteries – in a battery recycling bin at a supermarket, recycling centre, or via collection.
