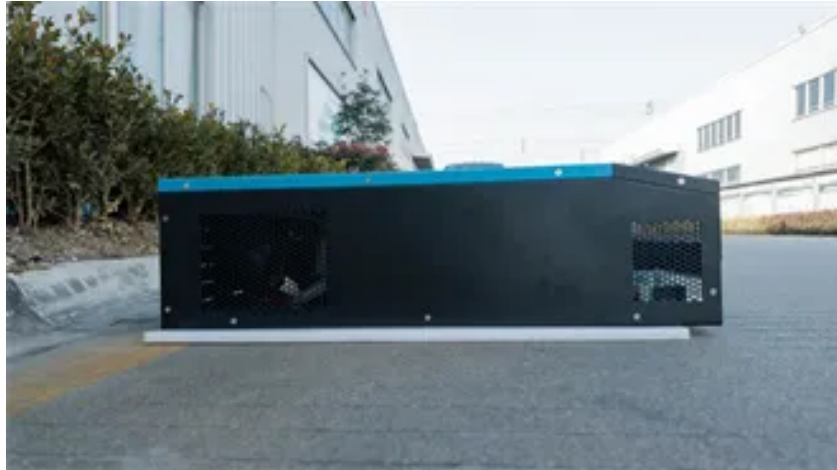

Full Breakdown of Thermal Imaging Standards

No solar radiation on any elevation in the preceding hour to the survey being carried out. Wind speeds during the survey should not exceed 5m/s. The survey should be carried out when the external ambient temperature has been within $\pm 2^{\circ}\text{C}$, 3 hours prior to and during the survey. Building surfaces should be dry.
