Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need a customs clearance / permission to progress (P2P)?

All goods for export must first obtain customs clearance or permission to progress (P2P) from CHIEF. Where it is required that the goods must remain under customs control on one of the transit procedures they must subsequently be declared to NCTS. Completion of this field with the Goods Location Code is mandatory for:

How do I make a customs clearance request?

Follow these steps when preparing to make a Customs Clearance Request on the Customs Declaration Service. Ensure that the goods are eligible to be declared using a Customs Clearance Request (CCR) or whether a written export customs declaration must be used.

Where can the goods to be exported be presented to customs?

The goods to be exported can be presented to customs at any other EU customs office – the Presentation Customs Office (PCO). AES enables the lodging of an export declaration prior to the expected presentation of goods to customs.



Do I need a customs EAD If I leave the EU?

Where goods are declared for export in the UK, but leave the EU via another member state, a customs EAD must accompany the goods to the office of exit. This is evidence that the consignment has been subject to export control in the UK. EU law requires that the export declaration is lodged in the exporter's member state.

Where can I lodge an export declaration?

A newly created UCC feature allowing a person to lodge an export declaration at the customs office where that person is established – the Supervising Customs Office (SCO). The goods to be exported can be presented to customs at any other EU customs office – the Presentation Customs Office (PCO).

Can CSE cleared goods travel in more than one container/load?

Consignments under CSE may also be travelling in more than one container/load. It is a requirement that all of the goods must be available at the nominated inland location at the goods available 'from' time. For CSE cleared goods exiting the EU via another member state no further messaging is required in the UK.
