Apparently, 2x lately, I've lost grid power so the system started pulling power from the batteries and the sun (but this is while running a 3 hp irrigation pump). At around 19% battery charge the system shut down completely. Since it is remote, the first time it was shut down close to two weeks, the second time for 2-3 days.
